Community Conservation Partnerships Grant An investment in outdoor recreation

Investing in outdoor recreational improvements plays a vital role in strengthening Blair County's economy and enhancing quality of life. Expanding and maintaining parks, trails, and recreational spaces attracts visitors, supports local businesses, and encourages new economic development centered around tourism and outdoor activity. These projects also make Blair County a more appealing place to live and work, helping to retain young professionals and families.



Achieving these goals can often come at a cost making viable financing options essential for success. Grant programs can play a crucial role in making that happen. One such grant program, Community Conservation Partnerships, managed by the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) Bureau of Recreation and Conservation (BRC), builds connections between Pennsylvanians and the outdoors by supporting recreational improvements, natural resource conservation, and community revitalization efforts.

Eligible organizations for DCNR grants vary by project type, but generally include county and municipal governments, municipal agencies, 501(c)3 non-profit organizations, and for-profit businesses (limited options). For most grants, DCNR accepts applications once annually. The application period opens the third Tuesday in January and closes the first Wednesday in April.
